<b>Criminology Units:</b> #Students must complete 24 points in their major – Crime Science. NOTE: BIO388 is currently timetabled to run in <u>WINTER</u> . CRM301 is timetabled to run in <u>SPRING</u> .  Criminology Required Units – must take CRM303 and CRM307.  Must take 6 points of <i>Criminology specified electives</i> (see list in handbook under course code B1345).					
It is strongly suggested to take BMS101 as an <i>option</i> ahead of BMS213. However, this is a suggestion and BMS101 is not a pre-requisite unit or part of the Crime Science major.  Do not exceed 10 units at level 100 (first year).
