#### Recommended Minor

##### Minor in Indigenous Knowledges and Practices (MN-IKP) – 12 points

If students wish to complete a minor in Indigenous Knowledges and Practices, students must select SIK102 Wandju Boodja (Welcome to Country) and complete SIK200, SIK201 and SIK300 or COD301; will need to use 12 points from the available 15 points of general electives.

#### Notes:

- Do not exceed 30 points at level 100 (first year).
- Check the university timetable each year to confirm the teaching period units run as they are subject to change.
