B) Japanese Major Structure - 24 credit points

Please note:

1. You can technically complete a Japanese Major with 24 points of any combinations of consecutive JPN units below. However, these units are sequential, so you need permission from the Unit Coordinator to enrol in a unit without completing the prerequisite lower unit.
2. You will also need to work with the Academic Chair to formalise a course variation if you complete 24 pts of JPN units but skip one or more out of: JPN101, JPN102, JPN201, JPN202 or JPN203.
3. If you complete more than 24 points of JPN units, the excess will be counted as General Electives points (Part C below). Please bear in mind that students with a Commonwealth Supported Place may not be allowed to enrol in units that lead to completing more than the 72 points that Murdoch BA requires. Unit enrolments exceeding 72 points may attract tuition fees at the Domestic/International Full Fee rate.

<p>Enrolment by application only; the unit level from (I) to (IV) is determined based on the applicant's study prior to participation in this in-country unit.
