**MJ-IE - International Education**

Semester 2 commencement, 2022



This course is designed for teaching professionals. It introduces the history and development of International Education as a field of study. It explores the conceptualisation of international mindedness and the trend to internationalise curriculum. It examines and critiques a range of international curriculum models and practices, and introduces the essential elements of the International Baccalaureate (IB) suite of programmes: Primary Years Programme, Middle Years Programme and Diploma Programme. Students develop a Teaching Portfolio throughout the course and have opportunities to observe and converse with international school teachers. The course is authorised and aligned to the IB Teaching and Learning Certificate.
