It examines and critiques a rangeof international curriculum models and practices, and introduces the essential elements of the International Baccalaureate (IB) suite of programmes: Primary Years Programme, Middle Years Programme and Diploma Programme. Students develop a Teaching Portfolio throughout the course and haveopportunities to observe and converse with international school teachers. The course is authorised and aligned to the IB Teaching and Learning Certificate.
