

C1154 Graduate Certificate in Gerontological Healthcare

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The Graduate Certificate in Gerontological Healthcare is a short course which can be completed within one semester full-time or spaced out across several semesters part-time. This course is suitable for students who wish to lead the care of older people with complex health conditions in contemporary care settings. As a health professional skilled in gerontological care, you will take a holistic, person-centred, and evidence-based approach to address older persons' physical, mental, emotional, social, and spiritual needs across the continuum of care.

This is a 12 credit-point course consisting of three core units specific to older person's health care and a 4th unit focusing on safety and quality in healthcare.

The course prerequisite is a recognised Bachelor Degree (AQF Level 7) in a health-related discipline.
