Course: **G1101 – Graduate Diploma in Counselling**

Credit points: 24

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The **Graduate Diploma in Counselling** is a 24-credit point course which can be completed within a year full-time or part-time across several years. This course is suitable for students who wish to attain entry-level qualifications at the most basic level for membership of the Australian Counselling Association (ACA). Successful completion of the Graduate Diploma in Counselling is required to apply to step up to the Master of Counselling.

Students enrolled in the Graduate Diploma in Counselling must enrol in all eight core units worth 3 credit points each:

- CSL505 Professional Counselling Skills (3cp)
- CSL504 Counselling Theories and Practice (3cp)
- CSL566 Case Conceptualisation and Assessment in Counselling (3cp)
- CSL581 Experiential Learning in Group Counselling (3cp)
- CSL501 Counselling Across the Lifespan (3cp)
- CSL500 Counselling Indigenous, Multicultural and Diverse Populations (3cp)
- CSL502 Mental Health Counselling (3cp)
- CSL503 Integrative Counselling Practice (3cp)
