- **EDN583** Professional Experience Secondary: Strategies for Effective Learning and Teaching (20 day placement = 5 dispersed days + 15 day block)
- **EDN690** Professional Experience Secondary: Differentiation within Diverse Contexts (20 day placement as a 4 week block)
- **EDN681** Final Professional Experience Secondary: Research in Practice (30 day placement as a 6 week block)
