

N1111 OnTrack Flex Enrolment Guide

Part-time enrolment plan for students commencing in Semester 2, 2025

Head of University Preparation Pathways: Dr. Noraisha Oyama

Students must pass 4 units to complete Ontrack Flex successfully.

Part-time students must pass the 2 core units before enrolling in the 2 disciplinary units.

How to Enrol part-time in Semester 2 (S2) 2025:

Enrol in the 2 core units for S2 2025 (Semester 2) and then enrol in the 2 disciplinary units for S1 2026 (Semester 1). This would take a student 1 year to complete OnTrack Flex.

Note that every student's university journey is different. Some students may choose to complete 1 unit per semester, which would take 2 years to complete OnTrack Flex. Students can drop a unit if their workload does not suit them. Students must make this amendment to their enrolment before Friday, 8th August.
