

Purpose and Scope

These Rules provide details of Murdoch's fees and charges.

The Senate decides which types of fees and charges may be imposed, by listing them in the *Fee Regulations*. The *Fee Regulations* delegate to the Vice Chancellor the authority to decide all the subsidiary details about fees and charges, by making rules containing this information.

Rules

1. In these rules, the following words have the following meanings:
 - 1.1. "Census Date" means the date at which a student's fee liability is assessed. The Census Dates for each Teaching Period are published at: <http://goto.murdoch.edu.au/TeachingPeriodsCensusDates>
 - 1.2. "Cohort" means a group of students commencing a Course of study in a particular year.
 - 1.3. "Commonwealth Supported Place" means a higher education place for which the Commonwealth Government makes a financial contribution.
 - 1.4. "Course" means a course offered and provided by Murdoch.
 - 1.5. "Domestic Tuition Fee Student" means an Australian citizen or Permanent Resident student who is paying tuition fees and is not the holder of a Commonwealth Supported Place.
 - 1.6. "HES Act" means the Commonwealth Government's *Higher Education Support Act 2003*.
 - 1.7. "International Student" means a person (whether within or outside Australia) who holds an Australian student visa, or a person who is not an Australian citizen, not a New Zealand citizen, or does not hold an Australian permanent resident visa, but does not include:
 - a Transnational Student; or
 - a Foreign Affairs student (within the meaning of the Migration Regulations 1994); or
 - a Defence student (within the meaning of the Migration Regulations 1994); or
 - a secondary exchange student (within the meaning of the Migration Regulations 1994); or

- an international student who has been approved under a scholarship scheme, or an exchange scheme, sponsored by the Commonwealth to undertake a Course of study or training in Australia; or
- a person who satisfies the secondary criteria, but not the primary criteria, under the Migration Regulations 1994 for the grant of the visa.

1.8. "Master Class" is defined in the *Non-award Study Procedure*.

1.9. "Microcredential" is defined in the *Non-award Study Procedure*.

1.10. "Murdoch Services" means services, facilities, equipment and/or materials that Murdoch makes available for use on a fee paying basis.

1.11. "Non-award" is defined in the *Non-award Study Policy*.

1.12. "Short Course" is defined in the *Non-award Study Procedure*.

1.13. "Single Unit/s Study" is defined in the *Non-award Study Procedure*.

1.14. "Transnational Student" means a student who is enrolled to study at a Murdoch location outside of Australia.

1.15. "Teaching Period" means the period of time during which all teaching and learning activities, including assessment, required to complete a Unit are scheduled and undertaken.

1.16. "Unit" means a discrete unit of study that is a basic course component.

2. **Student Services and Amenities Fee**

2.1. All enrolled Students are required to pay the Student Services and Amenities Fee, unless they fall within one of the exempt categories specified in Schedule A.

2.2. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of the Student Services and Amenities Fee on an annual basis, up to the maximum level permitted by Commonwealth Government pursuant to the *HES Act*, and in accordance with the directions on proportions of the fee to be charged for the Mandurah and Rockingham campuses and any other location from time to time established by Senate. The current level is detailed in Schedule A.

2.3. The liability for the Student Services and Amenities Fee is calculated from the student Unit enrolment as at 1 April for the first half of the academic year and 1 September for the second half of the academic year. Units are apportioned to the halves of the academic year based on their Unit census date. Payment of the liability is due at 1 April and 1 September of each year.

2.4. Students who withdraw from Units after the 1 April for the first half of the academic year and 1 September for the second half of the academic year are not entitled to a refund.

2.5. For the purpose of calculating the Student Services and Amenities Fee:

- 2.5.1. a full time student is a student enrolled in nine or more credit points in the relevant half of the academic year;

- 2.5.2. a part-time student is a student enrolled in less than 9 credit points in the relevant half of the academic year;
- 2.5.3. a wholly external student is a student enrolled in no face to face mode Units in the relevant half of the academic year
- 2.5.4. an on-campus student is classified as a Rockingham or Mandurah campus or other location student for a given half year if they are enrolled in a Rockingham, Mandurah or other location Course and are enrolled in at least one Unit in that campus at 1 April or 1 September; and
- 2.5.5. a student is classified as a Murdoch campus student for a given half year if they are not classified as transnational, wholly external, or a student classified under 2.5.4.
- 2.5.6. A Higher Degree by Research student will be considered wholly external for the purpose of calculating their Student Services and Amenities Fee.

3. Tuition Fees

3.1. International Tuition Fees

- 3.1.1. For the avoidance of doubt, the International Tuition Fee also applies to, and will be paid by, International Students enrolled on an external studies basis, unless the Vice Chancellor approves a different fee structure for the Course or Unit of study to be undertaken on an external studies basis.
- 3.1.2. The International Tuition Fee may vary for different student Cohorts.
- 3.1.3. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of the International Tuition Fees on an annual basis. The current fee levels are detailed in Schedule B.
- 3.1.4. Students, both new and continuing, may be eligible for a refund of International Tuition Fees paid, in the following circumstances:

3.1.7. Package Fee Refunds

3.1.8. If an International Student defers the commencement of a Course to a future Teaching Period, the indicative tuition fee payment will be transferred to that Teaching Period.

3.2. **Non-Commonwealth Supported Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fees**

- 3.2.1. All undergraduate Domestic Tuition Fee Students will pay a tuition fee ("Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fee").
- 3.2.2. The Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fee may vary for year of study.
- 3.2.3. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of the Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fee for each Unit of study on an annual basis. The current fee levels are detailed in Schedule C.
- 3.2.4. Students may be eligible for a refund of Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fees paid (see Rule 8.5).

3.3. **Non-Commonwealth Supported Domestic Postgraduate Tuition Fees**

- 3.3.1. All postgraduate students who are Australian or New Zealand citizens or Permanent Residents and are not Commonwealth supported are required to pay a tuition fee ("Domestic Postgraduate Tuition Fee"), unless the student has been awarded:
 - 3.3.1.1. a full tuition fee scholarship; or
 - 3.3.1.2. a research tuition fee waiver.
- 3.3.2. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of the Domestic Postgraduate Fees on an annual basis. The current fee levels are detailed in Schedule D.
- 3.3.3. Students may be eligible for a refund of Domestic Postgraduate Tuition Fees paid (see Rule 8.5).

3.4. **Single Unit/s Study Tuition Fees**

- 3.4.1. The level of the tuition fees for Units studied as Single Unit/s Study are:

- 3.4.2. The Single Unit/s Study Tuition Fee may vary for each year of study.
- 3.4.3. International Students may be eligible for a refund of tuition fees paid under Rule 3.1.4. Other students may be eligible for a refund of Tuition Fees paid under Rule 8.5 or remission of fees under Rule 8.6.

3.5. **Offshore Agreement Tuition Fees**

- 3.5.1. The level, timing and collection of fees payable by students and refund policy under agreements with Murdoch's offshore partners will be in accordance with the specific provisions of the individual agreement with each partner institution.
- 3.5.2. The Pro Vice Chancellor Transnational Education will make details of relevant fees available to students contemplating enrolling, or already enrolled, in any program offered by one of Murdoch's offshore partners.

3.6. **Fees for Non-government Microcredentials, Short Courses and Master Classes**

- 3.6.1. The Head of School or equivalent will set, collect and manage the fees for Short Courses, Master Classes and non-government funded Microcredentials.
- 3.6.2. Fees for Microcredentials and Short Courses will not be less than the fees for an equivalent Unit for a domestic fee-paying student.
- 3.6.3. Students applying to enrol in Microcredentials, Short Courses or Master Classes are required to pay any applicable fee upfront on enrolment.
- 3.6.4. Students who have paid a tuition fee for a non-government funded Microcredential, Short Course or Master Class may be eligible for a refund in the following circumstances:
- 3.6.4.1. the offer of a place is withdrawn or the University is unable to provide the program offered

- 3.6.4.2. the student withdraws prior to the commencement of the program.

3.7. Fee Discount

- 3.7.1. Any fee discounts must be in accordance with any applicable law.
- 3.7.2. Subject to Rule 3.7.3, any fee discount for a student cohort is subject to approval by the Vice Chancellor.
- 3.7.3. Rule 3.7.2 will not apply in respect of research masters or research doctoral degree scholarships, including any fee discount or waiver under such scholarships.

4. Administrative Fees

- 4.1. Director Student Administration may determine whether a student is liable for administrative fees. Students may be liable for administrative fees on the basis of:
 - 4.1.1. failure to adhere to approved enrolment/facility/payment deadlines;
 - 4.1.2. charges for goods or services provided to the student;
 - 4.1.3. recovery of bank and debt collection charges; or
 - 4.1.4. any other area allowable under relevant legislation.
- 4.2. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of each administrative fee on an annual basis. The current fee levels are detailed in Schedule E.

5. Student Accommodation

- 5.1. Rent, fees and charges in relation to on-campus student accommodation are levied by the provider of that accommodation, and that in the event of a failure to pay amounts owing, the accommodation provider may request that the University impose applicable penalties under Rule 11.

6. Murdoch Services Charges

- 6.1. Parties contracting to use Murdoch's Services specified in Schedule G will pay the applicable charges.
- 6.2. The Vice Chancellor approves the level of charges for the use of Murdoch's Services specified in Schedule G on an annual basis. The current charges are detailed in Schedule G.
- 6.3. For Murdoch Services related to audio visual and information technology, Director Information Technology Services will stipulate the University's terms of payment for these charges at the time of contracting.
- 6.4. For all other charges for the use of Murdoch's services related to the Property, Development and Commercial Services Office, Director Property and Commercial Services will stipulate the University's terms of payment for these charges at the time of contracting.

7. Student Contribution (SC) Fees

7.1. The HES Act determines the maximum level, timing and requirement for students in a Commonwealth-supported place to pay SC Fees.

7.2. The SC Fees for each Unit of study are detailed in Schedule H.

8. Fee Assessment, Refunds and Remission

8.1. Assessment for Tuition Fees and SC Fees is based on the student's enrolment as at the Census Date for the relevant semester, trimester or other academic period for which that student is enrolled.

8.2. Students who withdraw before the Census Date, or whose enrolment as at that date attracts a lower fee than that paid, may be entitled to a refund. Any such refund is subject to the restrictions and limitations detailed for the specific type of fee as detailed in the preceding rules.

8.3. Director Student Administration will determine whether a student can receive a fee refund.

8.4. The amount of any refund will be the difference between the fee liability and the amount actually paid.

8.5. Subject to Rules 3.1.4, 3.4.2, 8.3 and 8.4, a student who has paid any one or more of Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fees, Domestic Postgraduate Tuition Fees, government funded Microcredential Tuition Fees or domestic Single Unit/s Study Tuition may be eligible for a refund in the following circumstances:

8.6. Where a student falls under the requirements of the HES Act for HECS-HELP or FEE-HELP remission, those decisions will be made in accordance with the HES Act by Director Student Administration.

8.7. Where a student is not covered by the HES Act, and the student:

8.7.1. has been enrolled in a Unit at the University;

- 8.7.2. has not completed the requirements of the Unit during the Teaching Period in which the student undertook, or was to undertake, the Unit; and
- 8.7.3. withdraws from that Unit after the end of the Census Date of the Teaching Period for the Unit,

then the student may be entitled to remission of fees paid to the University in respect of the Unit if they can demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the Director Student Administration, circumstances that:

- 8.7.4. are beyond the student's control;
- 8.7.5. do not make their full impact on the student until on or after the Census Date for the Unit; and
- 8.7.6. make it impracticable for the student to complete the requirements for the Unit during the Teaching Period in which the student undertook, or was to undertake, the Unit.

8.8. The student must apply for remission in writing:

- 8.8.1. if the student has withdrawn from their enrolment in the Unit and the University gives notice to the student that the withdrawal has taken effect, within 12 months after the withdrawal date specified in the notice; or
- 8.8.2. otherwise, 12 months after the end of the Teaching Period during which the student undertook, or was to undertake, the Unit,

unless the Director Student Administration waives the requirement that the application be made before the end of that period on the ground that it would not be, or was not, possible for the application to be made before the end of that period.

9. **Payment deadlines**

- 9.1. The due date for payment of all fees payable under these Fee Rules is the number of days after the issue date of the relevant invoice:
 - 9.1.1. Student Services and Amenities Fee – 14 days after issue date as shown on invoice.
 - 9.1.2. International Tuition Fees – first day of the Teaching Period. Where enrolment is amended after the start of the Teaching Period, the due date is the earlier of 14 days from the change in enrolment, or the Census Date.
 - 9.1.3. Domestic Undergraduate Tuition Fees – first day of semester. Where enrolment is amended after the start of semester, the due date is the earlier of 14 days from the change in enrolment, or the Census Date.
 - 9.1.4. Domestic Postgraduate Tuition Fees Up front – first day of semester. Where enrolment is amended after the start of

semester, the due date is the earlier of 14 days from the change in enrolment, or the Census Date.

- 9.1.5. Single Unit/s Study Tuition Fees – first day of the relevant teaching period.
- 9.1.6. Fees for Non-government Microcredentials, Short Courses and Master Classes – as specified by Head of School.
- 9.1.7. Administrative Fees – 14 days after issue date as shown on invoice.
- 9.1.8. Deposit and rental charges – 7 days after issue date as shown on initial invoice, with all further payments in advance of the rental period.
- 9.1.9. Upfront Commonwealth supported student contribution amounts – the earlier of 14 days after the start of the Teaching Period, or 7 days before the Census Date of the Teaching Period.
- 9.1.10. Murdoch's Services Charges – as specified in the written contract.

10. Financial Hardship

- 10.1. Students in exceptional financial hardship and who are unable to apply for assistance under HELP may apply to pay their Student Services and Amenities Fee and/or their Tuition Fees (excluding Commonwealth Supported SC Fees, fees for non-government Microcredentials, Short Courses, Master Classes and amounts payable under an offshore agreement) by instalments.
- 10.2. All applications must be made:
 - 10.2.1. in writing using the Application for an Extension of Time to Pay Fees form, with full details of the circumstances supporting the claim of exceptional financial hardship;
 - 10.2.2. to Student Central; and
 - 10.2.3. as soon as possible after receipt of the relevant fee invoice and prior to the original due date for payment.
- 10.3. Applicants under this Rule will provide such additional or supplementary information and/or documentation as the Director Student Administration reasonably requests in order to make a decision on the application.
- 10.4. Applications made after the due date may only be accepted in exceptional circumstances.
- 10.5. The Director Student Administration is responsible for determining the outcome of the application.

11. Penalties for non-payment of fees

- 11.1. Director Student Administration may impose or exercise the following penalties for the non-payment of any amounts payable or referred to under these Rules:

12. Publication of Rules

12.1. Murdoch will publish these Rules by any one or more of the following means:

- 12.1.1. a copy will be placed on Murdoch's website;
- 12.1.2. a link to the Rules will be placed in Murdoch's student fees website; and

12.1.3. the fees section of Murdoch's Handbook and Calendar will include reference to the existence of these Rules and their URL on Murdoch's legislation website.

12.2. The various schedules to these Rules will continue to apply from year to year in the absence of the Vice Chancellor approving in writing a replacement or update to the schedule or schedules in any particular year.
