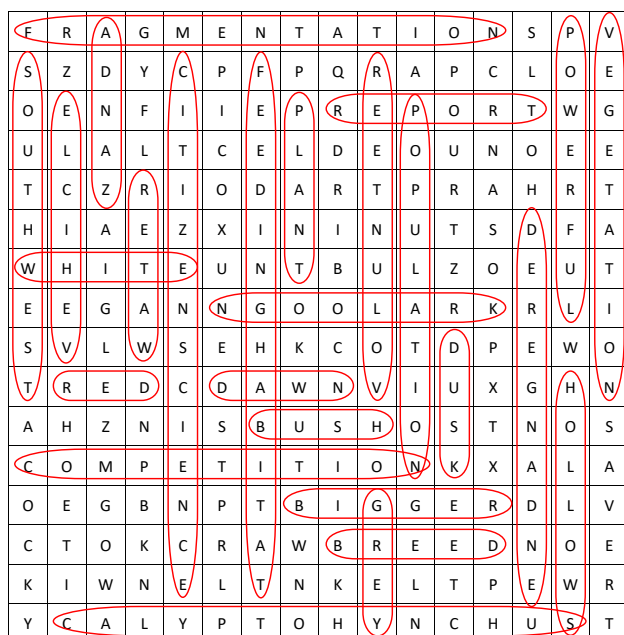

- The scientific name for Carnaby's Cockatoo is **Zanda** latiostris.
- Ngoolark** is the Noongar name for Carnaby's Cockatoo.
- Carnaby's cockatoo has experienced a continued **population** decline since the 1950s
- Carnaby's cockatoo is a **white**-tailed black cockatoo
- Male Carnaby Cockatoos have **red** eye rings
- Female Carnaby Cockatoos have **grey** eye rings
- Loss of **feeding habitat** is considered the principal threat to the Carnaby's Cockatoo
- Habitant **fragmentation** is a major threat to Carnaby's black cockatoos because it means they need to travel longer distances to feed and drink.
- Competition** for nest hollows with other birds impacts Carnaby's Cockatoo
- Installing artificial nesting hollows allow cockatoos to **breed** in areas where natural **hollows** are now limited.
- Carnaby's cockatoos are **bigger** than Baudins cockatoo
- The Great Cocky Count is a long-term **citizen science** survey that monitors known roost sites of Carnaby's cockatoos
- Anyone can **volunteer** for the Great Cocky Count.
- An Australian nickname for Cockatoos is **Cocky**
- Carnaby's cockatoo is found in the **South West** of Western Australia
- Ngoolarks are most often observed in flocks at **dawn** or **dusk** as they leave or return to a roost site
- Carnaby's black cockatoos are **endangered**
- Extensive clearing of native **vegetation** has reduced Carnaby cockatoo breeding habitat
- Carnaby's Cockatoos are often killed and injured by motor **vehicle** strike because they feed in native bushland along the road and due to their size, they need time to take off.
- The Carnaby's **powerful** bill chews through cones, nuts and seeds of Banksia, Dryandra, Hakea, Eucalyptus, Corymbia and Grevillea species.
- We should always **report** injured black cockatoos to Kaarakin
- We can all help **keep Carnaby's flying** if we protect nesting hollows, **plant** native black cockatoo foraging species in our garden, protect remnant **bush**, and put out a permanently clean and full **water** source, even a small bird bath!
