***Adolescents Perception of Masculinity:  
Examining Character Education within an Australian All Boys School***

Hegemonic masculinity remains pervasive within Australian society however early adolescence (10-14 years) is crucial to cultivating healthier perspectives. Utilising Connell's (1987) hierarchies of masculinities, this mixed-methods study investigated the perceptions of Year 9 boys (through survey) and their teachers (through interview) following delivery of a character education program at an all-boys school. Findings reiterate knowledge on effective program delivery whilst emphasising new priorities and the need for further research on shaping healthy masculinities.

***A Narrative Inquiry of Developing Nurse Identity: The Experiences of Students in a  
Vocational Education and Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS) Nursing Course***

This thesis describes the experiences of students enrolled in a Vocational Education and Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VETDSS) nursing course. Drawing on student narratives it investigates the geographical, practical, cultural, social, and institutional influences on their nurse identity formation. Findings reveal that students' families, friends, and local communities play a significant role in their desire to become nurses. The research has implications for attracting and training nursing students.

***The Effect of Personality and Mindset on the Well-Being of Students During the Transition  
from Primary School to Secondary School***

This research analysed the relationships between personality, mindset, and well-being during the transition from primary school to secondary school, using structural equation modelling to run regressions between personality (using the Big 5 personality traits) and mindset with well-being (using five well-being subscales from the Youth Radar tool) over the period. Significant relationships resulting in better or worse well-being were found. These were discussed and applicable interventions were recommended.

### ***Carbon Management Accounting Adoption: Determinants and Its Impact on Corporate Performance***

Grounded in contingency theory, this study explores the adoption of Carbon Management Accounting (CMA) within a developing country context. It examines key determinants influencing CMA adoption and analyses its impact on the environmental and financial performance of manufacturing companies in Indonesia. The findings offer practical insights for managers and practitioners in streamlining contingency aspects that contribute to an effective CMA, in enhancing climate change responsiveness while delivering economic value.

### ***Founder Chief Executive Officer, and corporate decisions: Evidence from Australia***

This research examines how Founder CEOs influence financial decisions in Australian listed companies. Using data from 2012 to 2021, it finds that founder-led firms use less debt, show lower executive opportunism, and have more stable earnings. These effects are stronger when founders have higher ownership and when institutional investors monitor effectively. The study highlights that founder leadership, supported by good governance, promotes discipline and long-term value creation.

### ***Inequities in the utilization of maternal healthcare services in low- and middle-income countries: comparative insights from Bangladesh and Pakistan***

My PhD research examined inequities in maternal healthcare in Bangladesh and Pakistan, focusing on service use, family planning, and costs. Analysis of national survey data showed that wealth, education, and rural residence strongly shaped utilization to antenatal and postnatal care. The poorest women faced the heaviest out-of-pocket costs, often resulting in catastrophic health spending. These findings highlight the urgent need for targeted policies to strengthen equity in maternal and reproductive healthcare services.

***Redefining graduate work readiness: From conceptualisation to operationalisation***

This mixed-methods research developed and validated a new measurement tool for graduate work readiness. Based on a new conceptual model informed by literature and employer needs, the tool was tested with university students and graduates in Mauritius. The key findings identified seven key skills employers value, which university students and graduates still lack. This validated measurement tool can be used to monitor and improve graduate work readiness in universities.

***The Validity of Policy Interventions to Address Australian School Segregation***

The research considers the appropriateness of policy reforms to address socioeconomic school segregation and its associated compositional effects in Australia. Its significance is to recent federal government inquiries into school equity that have considered the effects of school segregation on learning outcomes. Its key findings were that the compositional effect is real and substantive, it varies between schooling systems due to policy settings, and it is partially associated with the structure of Australia's schooling system.
