Untangling Prince Charming: The Role of Scambaiters in the Performance of Romance Fraud and Pig-Butchering Scams

This thesis examines romance fraud and pig-butchering attempts by analysing text conversations with scambaiters. It addresses gaps in knowledge about perpetrator behaviour, their social engineering tactics, and the roles they play throughout the interaction. The findings indicate fraudsters follow scripts and utilise roles which portray credibility and affluence, which are disrupted by scambaiters non-conformity to their expectations. Thus, it also sheds light on the use of scambaiting as a tool for research and prevention.

Metaphor, Material Artefact, and Action in Art Practice

This creative practice-based research arose out of doing art. It is founded in material investigation and became part of the discourse and intra-actions that define computer hardware, software and human. The thesis embraced the anomalous, over the repeatable, investigating the role of material and conceptual metaphor in the emergence of thoughts and bits from material discursive processes. It found that material and conceptual metaphor hold key roles in a discursive, ongoing boundary making process.

Viewing film music through the lens of original film music and pre-existing music, this research explores how filmmakers use of music is influenced by audiences. This thesis provides an understanding of how music influences the meaning made from film, from the perspective of both the filmmaker and the audience. The research led to the practical application of theory, namely two versions of an original short film.
