

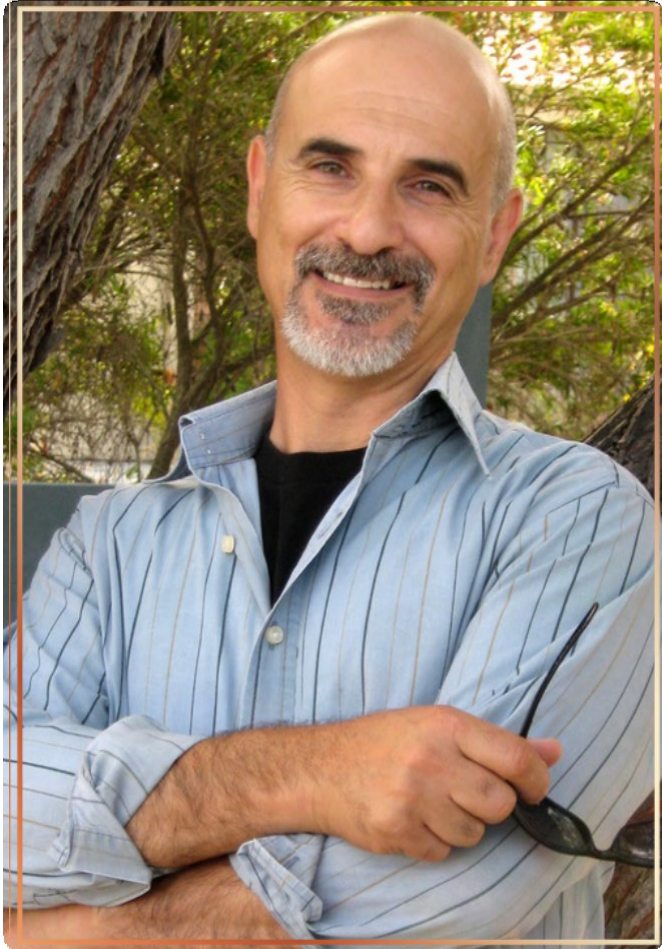


Dr. Sangay Wangchuk
