In PASS we will break down tricky concepts to make them more manageable, and I will share the best study tips and tricks.



So I'll see you at PASS for ICT283.



I hope my recent experience in your shoes and my contagious attitude to group learning will see us facing and succeeding in the challenges we face as students; the rewards are immense.


